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in the 21st century corporations have worked their way into government and as they become increasingly more powerful arguments about their involvement with public health have become increasingly black and white with corporations at the center of public health and environmental issues everything chemical or technological is good everything natural is bad scientists who are funded by corporations are right and those who are independent are invariably wrong there is diminishing common ground between the two opposed sides in these arguments corporate ties that bind is a collection of essays written by influential academic scholars activists and epidemiologists from around the world that scrutinize the corporate reasoning false science and trickery

involving those like in house epidemiologists who mediate the scientific message of organizations who attack and censure independent voices this book addresses how the growth of corporatism is destroying liberal democracy and personal choice whether addressing asbestos radiation pcbs or vaccine regulation the essays here address the dangers of trusting corporations and uncover the lengths to which corporations put profits before health

the author studied the works of early doctors scientists and genius laypeople who spent years studying different theories about the nature of cancer many of them had high success rates with patients who d been sent home to die after being exposed to conventional therapies then she found doctors who have studied the work of these early and later cancer pioneers who have high success rates in their cancer practices now when cancer is not a mystery it does not have to be a death sentence

mcdonnell here offers some startling new ways to think about propaganda specifically about health campaigns he uses hiv aids media campaigns in ghana as his case laying out efforts to control and organize how local communities make sense of the disease using media to change people s sexual practices involves evidence based design opinion leaders in the design process and getting all organizations behind a single message but these campaigns hardly ever work why they are subject to cultural misfires they are disrupted by misinterpretation and misuse enter cultural entropy this concept identifies a process through which intended meanings and uses of propaganda and other cultural objects fracture into alternative meanings new practices failed interactions and blatant disregard the book shows with exquisite ethnographic details how the aids media campaigns succumb to cultural entropy e g how people turn female condoms into bracelets aids posters go missing from public postings and become home decor and red ribbons fade into pink ribbons under the sun cultural entropy is a disruption process that affects things as well as symbols cultural entropy offers a new explanation for the failure of aids campaigns specifically and modern interventions broadly

this handbook explores the ways biomedicine and pop culture interact while simultaneously introducing the reader with the tools and ideas behind this new field of enquiry from comic books to health professionals from the arts to genetics from sci fi to medical education from tv series to ethics it offers different entry points to an

exciting and central aspect of contemporary culture how and what we learn about and from scientific knowledge and its representation in pop culture divided into three sections the handbook surveys the basics the micro and the macroaspects of this interaction between specialized knowledge and cultural production after the introduction of basic concepts of and approaches to the topic from a variety of disciplines the respective theories and methods are applied in specific case studies the final section is concerned with larger social and historical trends of the use of biomedical knowledge in popular culture presenting over twenty five original articles from international scholars with different disciplinary backgrounds this handbook introduces the topic of pop culture and biomedicine to both new and mature researchers alike the articles all complete with a rich source of further references are aimed at being a sincere entry point to researchers and academic educators interested in this somewhat unexplored field of culture and biomedicine

the health of our global environment is increasingly affected by our technological advance rain rivers lakes forests soil climate all suffer at human hands laura and cotton suggest that the society committed to the technological transformation of the natural environment into an artificial one is also paradoxically a society

committed to its own destruction currently one of the major concerns of environmental education is to address this problem more concerted than hitherto this book represents a radical departure from the traditional approach to environmental education it argues that the knowledge base behind current teaching is flawed and the resulting mind sets and attitudes are often counterproductive to the aims of environmental education

mad studies the basics provides an introductory account of a field that emerged from and must remain grounded within community knowledge activism and the perspectives of those who have experienced madness and mental health systems it is a concise text that introduces the field through an exploration of some origins of mad studies as well as two interrelated queries what does mad studies help us understand and what does mad studies help us do this exploration reveals that mad studies is an interdisciplinary intersectional and multi vocal field that demands different answers to the very meaning of the beliefs behaviours and bodymind experiences that are currently characterized as being indicative of mental illness at the heart of mad studies is a liberationist desire to resist transform and abolish the systems that create marginalization and implement responses to madness that are grounded in the collective knowledge of those deemed mad this book shows that the contributions of indigenous black racialized queer and trans people must be understood as central to and already embedded within mad studies and activism rather than as add ons expansions or efforts to make mad studies more inclusive it will be of interest to all scholars and students of disability studies social work gender studies education health sciences sociology and psychology as well as practitioners in mental health care and those with lived experience of madness and mental health systems

the biomedical paradigm describes the underlying philosophy or pattern of thinking behind modern medicine what if the biomedical paradigm is fundamentally flawed resulting in 95 of modern medicine being scientifically and medically wrong doctors are mostly nice hard working and respectable people but what if they are killing and injuring many many times more people than they are healing because of their insane belief in the biomedical paradigm they have already been remarkably successful in killing millions of people with vaccinations chemotherapy and hiv aids they now want to create a medically induced bird flu pandemic that

could kill tens of millions of people they will succeed in this endeavour unless enough ordinary people understand the horror that is the biomedical paradigm back cover
